



SAFETY TIPS

THEFT OUT OF MOTOR VEHICLE



This offence is committed when a person unlawfully takes or attempts to take possession of any movable property of another in a motor vehicle with the intent to deprive him/her thereof.

Safety tips:

- Ensure that your car doors are locked at all times.
- When locking your car by use of a remote, touch the handle of the door to make sure that it is indeed locked.
- Do not leave valuable items on the car seats e.g Laptops, cellphones or handbags.
- Put everything away in a glove compartment or boot or just out of plain sight. (I think it still motivate people to leave items in their vehicles its contradicting with bullet point no 2)
- When driving, make sure your windows are rolled up and all doors are locked.
- Avoid parking in poorly lit areas and streets.

Are you aware?

Car breakers normally hide around parking areas, monitoring you while parking. When leaving your vehicle and trying to lock it by use of a remote; they will jam your remote signal not to lock the vehicle.
